# LSC vs ALSC

	<b>LSC</b> (Local School Council)	<b>ALSC</b> (Advisory Local School Council)
<b>Parent representation</b>	Parent majority required by law (6 out of 11 at elem., 6 out of 12 at HS).	Parents no longer in majority due to 2 additional required “advocate” positions.
<b>Community representation</b>	Parents and residents vote for community representatives.	Board appoints community representatives based on recommendation of CEO using any names including those on list created by ALSC and AIO.
<b>Accountability</b>	Elected by parents and community of local school every two years.	Appointed by CPS.
<b>Authority</b>	Selects principal.	May advise CEO on principal appointment, but only after being trained by CPS Office of LSC Relations.
	Makes budget transfers.	May only transfer funds if principal approves.
	Reports to the community on school progress.	Principal reports to the community.
<b>Removal</b>	Member may be removed by the Board if problems with eligibility (training, eligibility, criminal or ethics disclosure lapses) are found. May be removed by the LSC for non-attendance.	May be removed by the Board for all of the same reasons as the LSC, but <i>also</i> if CPS finds “unbecoming conduct” which is broadly defined.
